
Two new benches installed at Milking Brook.

Gorsemoor Road cleared paths.




Heath Way, cleared paths.

Cut tree and removed fallen tree, weeded, litter picked and created four more spaces, disabled plots cleaned.




Kent Place cleared moss, leaves, sanded and painted 3 benches.
