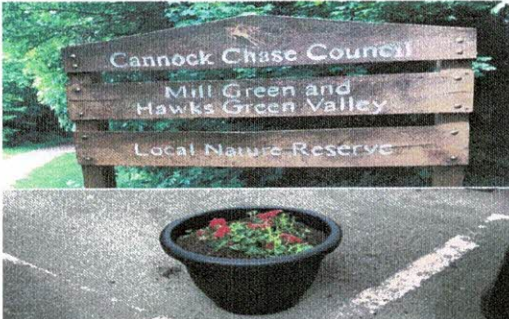
Cleared weeds from Brooklyn Road.

Strimmed hedge along St Lawrence Drive.

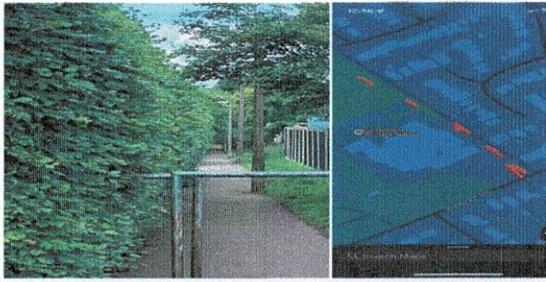
Resolved: To increase the Handyman's allowance from £12 per month to £24 per month for use of own tools.

Hednesford Road, trim bushes.



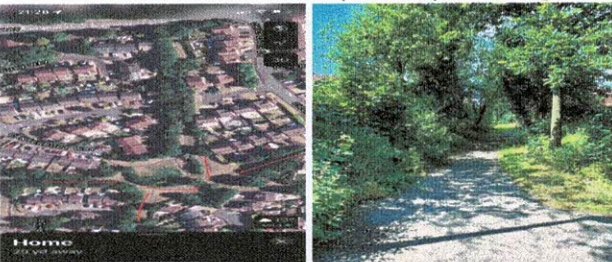
Cut back the hedge, visibility is poor turning out of Deavall Way.

Cut back bushes around the pathways starting at Chichester Drive.





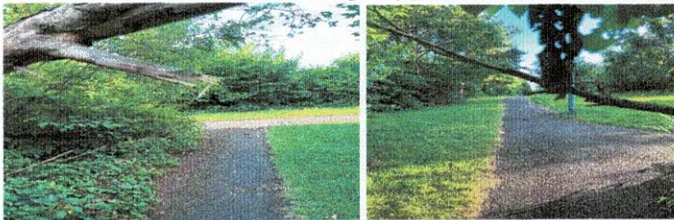
Clear pathways between Meadow Way.
