#### 3. Remembrance Sunday

Improvements required for 2022 would be the sound, the service had been difficult to hear. Speakers would be required to be mounted on stands or a table, ideally if an electric point could be installed in the park, a main operated system would be far more efficient, assistance required to adjust the heights of the mics. The road closure order needed to be for longer and barriers only put across the street to coincide with the official road closure order, each barrier required a marshal. 16 marshals in total would be required and to march back down Hednesford Road to the Church.
